

Below is important information you will need to get prepared for your trip to Liberia.

SECTION I: IMMUNIZATION THAT YOU WILL NEED TO TAKE

1. Hepatitis A & B or Combo (Highly Recommended)
 - A. About \$20.00 per shot
 - B. One shot now; another six to twelve months later provides lifetime protection.
2. Yellow Fever (REQUIRED)
 - A. About \$60.00
 - B. One shot; good for ten years
3. Typhoid (Highly Recommended)
 - A. About \$40.00
 - B. One shot; good for two years
4. Tetanus-diphtheria (Highly Recommended)
 - A. About \$5.00
 - B. One shot; good for five years
5. Malaria Pills (Highly Recommended)
 - A. Begin taking 7 days prior to departure (some say 30 days)

SECTION IV: INFORMATION ON LIBERIA VISA APPLICATION

TYPE OF VISAS ISSUED

Consular section opens from 10:00 A.M. to 2:30 P.M. Monday through Friday.

There is a waiting Period of Seven (7) working days for processing of visas.

In accordance with International Health Regulations, all persons entering Liberia are required to have a Valid Certificate of Immunization against Yellow Fever.

- e. Evidence of financial support.
- f. Letter requesting for visa and place of accommodation in Liberia. v
- g. Self addressed prepaid envelope (overnight) for return of passport. v
